Launched in 2015, IGrow South City Garden is part of an urban farming and community gardening initiative that aims to increase access to healthy food for populations at risk of being food insecure (residing in food deserts). The project will also expand on Tallahassee Food Network's (TFN) 'IGrow Whatever You Like" urban agriculture and youth empowerment program. The purposes of IGrow, as drafted by the youth themselves, are to 1) Grow good food for the community, 2) provide meaningful employment (paid and volunteer) to youth, and 3) teach and empower youth to teach others how to grow good food.
